Resident Spotlight - Kathleen Theissen

Kathleen opened our conversation by saying, “I don’t think I have done much for you to write about.” Then began my whirlwind tour of her life’s work; the sharing of her love of God and the building of His church. After college she joined World Impact as a worker in a ghetto in Portland, Oregon. For twelve years she fought poverty in all its forms in an effort to address the needs presented to her. She also married and started a family.

The Portland mission changed and there followed moves for her husband Carl’s work from California to Chicago where her church affiliation afforded her two shorter mission trips, one to India and one to South Sudan where she found herself on 9/11. She remembers being shown to the hut where she would be housed (including a look into the bomb shelter) and the rousing prayer of her hosts as they confronted the difficulties of a return to the United States. Ongoingly, and through her love of music, she headed a youth ministry and eventually became the director of an International House of Prayer which provided combined prayer and worship daily. So much for a quiet life!

Her move to Boise is now changing her focus to children and grandchildren, wanting to share with them exactly who she is and her love of the Lord. In spite of major health concerns, she has also written and prepared for publication a beautiful devotional book. Sustainer of My Heart is available through Amazon.
